

MISSION STATEMENT

DISTRICT I IHSAA BOARD OF CONTROL (REVISED MARCH, 2000)

It is the purpose of the District I Board of Control to promote, organize, coordinate, and manage all interscholastic and extracurricular activities in District I sanctioned by and subject to the rules, procedures and regulations of the Idaho High School Activities Association.

All students enrolled in the programs are provided the opportunity to participate and develop their special interests and talents on an equitable and fair basis.

FUNCTIONS OF THE DISTRICT I BOARD OF CONTROL ARE:

1. Select, foster and govern interschool competitions and activities in athletics, music, speech, drill teams, cheerleading and other similarly related school activities for secondary schools grades nine through twelve.
2. Encourage, regulate and give directions to wholesome amateur interscholastic activities and athletic competitions between schools who are members of District I.
3. Determine qualifications of individual students, coaches and officials and provide and establish standards of eligibility, competition and sportsmanship.
4. Develop uniform rules and provide interpretations as needed for fair and equitable management.
